APRIL SERVICE PROJECT – BABY CARE KITS: The need is dire for baby care kits. Bringing a baby into the world can be a difficult and scary thing for a mother living in poverty or experiencing a disaster. When natural disaster strikes or political conflict flares, families often have little chance to gather their belongings before fleeing the danger. These few items make a difference and tell them 'we care'. Resurrection Lutheran Baby Care Kits are sent directly to a LWR warehouse so they can be used where the need is greatest. In 2012, Baby Care Kits were sent to the area flooded in the Philippines where 200,000 people were displaced.

Each Baby Care Kit (6 to 24 months) should include the following new items:

Two onesies or T-shirts

Two gowns or sleepers without feet. Top/pant set can be substituted Two 52" square receiving blankets

Four cloth diapers - flat fold preferred

One sweater or sweatshirt (with hood or baby cap)

One hand towel, dark color

Two bath-size bar (4/5 oz.) of gentle soap in its original wrapping

Two pair of socks

Two large diaper pins
