CONGREGATIONAL COUNCIL MEETING: The next council meeting will be held on Tuesday October 11th, 2022, at 5:30 pm. The Council approved the following August Tithing: RLCA Good Samaritan Fund - \$372.84, Food for the Poor - \$279.63 and One Hope \$279.63.

RLCA – September/October Monthly Service Activity – Christmas Shoe Boxes - Operation Christmas Child is a project of the international relief Samaritan's Purse. Resurrection Lutheran has the opportunity to touch the lives of suffering children in over 100 countries – last year's boxes were shipped to Ecuador. Over 8.6 million hurting children experience the joy of Christmas because of these shoe boxes. You can do three things. 1.) Fill shoe boxes, 2.) pray for the children who will receive the gifts and 3.) pray for their families, countries and for the national partners in each distribution country. Our job of filling boxes is easy, but delivery is not an easy job. Our delivery starts with our boxes being delivered to an Alpena drop off church, Living Hope. Shoe boxes will be available with complete directions inside.
