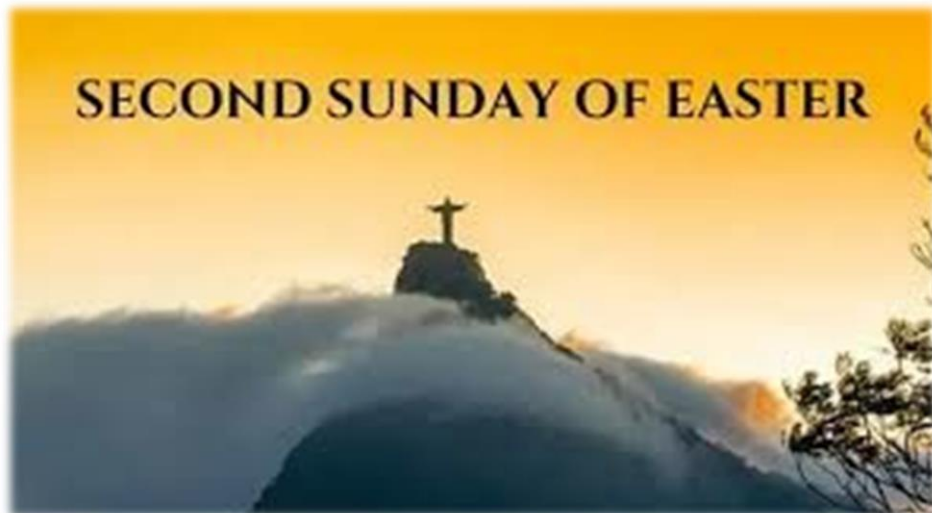
CONGREGATIONAL COUNCIL MEETING: The next council meeting will be held on Tuesday, May 9, 2023, at 5:30 pm.

Resurrection Lutheran will be collecting items to complete personal care kits. This Lenten season, as our congregation journeys toward the cross, let us also walk with people in need. Ukraine and earthquake victims need our help. LWR Personal Care Kits offer simple tools that give an extraordinary gift – the preservation of one’s God-given dignity and staying healthy for a “future with hope.” (Jeremiah 29:11) Please feel free to donate **individual items** if you do not want to do an entire kit. Or, donate the items and we’ll put them together for you.

- One bath-size towel (approx. 52” x 27”), dark color
- Two bath-size bars (4-5 oz.) of soap, in original wrapping
- One adult-size toothbrush in its original packaging (no toothpaste)
- One sturdy comb, remove packaging
- One metal nail clipper, remove packaging

Do not add other items or leave out any of the item. All items should be new. Wrap items in towel and tie securely with ribbons or yarn. Do not enclose the Kit or any of its contents in plastic bags.
