### Notes from the Treasurer—Annette Kindt

- AAACU Money Market (MM) ending July 31, 2023 General Fund (GF) \$62,207.02, Feeding Kids Ministry (FKM) \$45,447.49 & Property Management (PM) \$4,951.50, all are earning 1.20% GF MM funds decreased by \$50,000.00 due to opening a 12-month Certificate of Deposit (CD) in the same amount that earns 5.00% APR. A transaction of \$500.00 from GF savings and \$10,000.00 from the GF checking transferred to the GF MM for better interest rates. MM for FKM increased by \$48.01 while the MM funds for PM decreased by \$3,296.43 due to Summer 2023 property taxes paid on the parsonage.
- Edward Jones Investments earned \$2,280.75 in July. Our year-to-date gain is \$10,674.45. The total portfolio summary held at Edward Jones is \$107,686.88. This money is used to maintain the parsonage located at 151 N Oliver St.
- The approved budget for 2023-24 requires monthly offerings of \$10,000; the offering received for the five weeks in July totaled \$9,810.00; a shortfall of \$190.00. Please consider adding \$1 or \$2 more dollars to your giving to help us reach and maintain our monthly needs.
- Revenues were in the positive by \$2,461.78 over liabilities for the month of July but keep in mind we are paying supply pastor rates at this time for Pastor Doug and not full-time wages. All in all; July was a good month. Thanks be to God!
