CONGREGATIONAL COUNCIL MEETING: The next council meeting will be held on Tuesday February 13, 2024, at 5:30 pm.

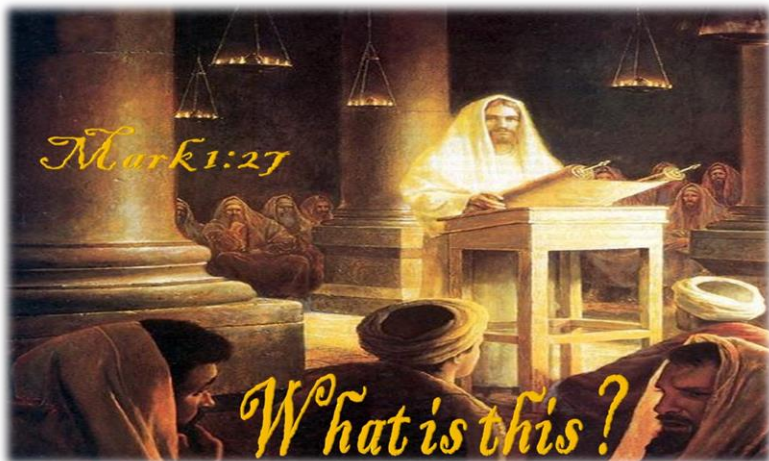
