FKM Quarterly Newsletter

It has been a great quarter for Feeding Kids Ministry. We have packed 2,987 bags for approximately 17,922 meals for this quarter.

Donations have been coming in slowly but steadily. We have received a portion of the Arby's grant awarded to The Food Bank of Eastern Michigan. Donations came in from National Christian Foundation of MI, HPC credit union, RLCA local donation.

We have been chosen to participate in 2 local charity events in the community. "Coffee for a Cause" through Cabin Creek in December and 50/50 raffle at the Aplex for one of the events. They will announce when they decide which one is ours.

We have purchased a 7-month supply of bags for FKM. We have ordered all new bins for the line. They are amazing and sturdy.

We have been blessed with Becky Witt as a new volunteer. She has taken on a roll of helping with tasks around fundraising events. She is a whiz at flyers, advertising and organization.

The FKM Spring Bazaar was a smashing success. We brought in about \$4000 in surplus. The event consisted of 30 vendors, a bake sale, plant sale and a whole FKM sale room. We brought in over 400 customers to our first show. We have a buzz about FKM.

I look forward to seeing what else we can do to bring this into our community and having the funding come in, have more volunteer opportunities and so many more things to look forward to. A Note from the Treasurer

Notes from the Treasurer:

- AAACU Money Market ending February 2024 General Fund \$62,779.95, Feeding Kids Ministry \$49,830.39 & Property Managment \$3,037.15 all are earning 1.85%. Our \$50,000 CD continues to grow, as of February 29th the interest paid is \$1,268.11 for a grand total of \$51,268.11. The maturity date is July 5,2024.
- Edward Jones Investments gained \$2,630.29 in February. Our year-to-date for EJ is a gain of \$3,061.39.
- Offerings continue to be lower than our monthly budget needs; this continued trend will create a need for us to get into the money market funds to keep the church afloat once we begin to pay Pastor Doug wages and housing expenses. I highly encourage you to look at your budget and give where you can. If 40 members gave \$8.00 more per month we would meet our budgeted needs. That is less then the cost of a pizza!
