RLCA May/June Service Activity: Personal Care Kits (Entire kits or individual items are welcome!) A complete kit includes:
• One bath-size towel (approx. 52” x 27”), light-weight, dark color
• One wash cloth, dark color
• One bath-size bar (4 to 5 oz.) of soap in original wrapping.
• One adult toothbrush in original packaging.
• One full-size toothpaste in original packaging
• One sturdy comb, remove packaging.
• Six band-aids secured with rubber band
• One metal nail file or clippers, remove packaging.

All items should be new. **Wrap smaller items in washcloth, then wrap all items in the towel and tie securely with ribbon or yarn.**
→ Do not enclose the kit or any of its contents in plastic bags.
